Dear colleagues,

We have a job opening in our team, which we intend to fill via an assessed internship. Such an internship is a paid position of 3-6 months, which will lead to a job offer if both parties are happy with the experiences during the internship. The candidate should be close to completion of a PhD (or MSc if an excellent student). We are looking for a candidate with a broad interest in statistics and chemometrics. Our team covers a wide range of topics, as further described below.

Internships with Shell in the Netherlands

We are looking for: Students studying for a PhD or Masters, interested in applying their statistical skills, who would like to get some international work experience. Fluent English is a pre-requisite.

We offer: a paid internship of 3-6 months duration in Amsterdam, working on one or a number of projects depending on the area of interest and the skills of the candidate. Accommodation support and an allowance is provided. Students close to the end of their studies can apply for an "Assessed Internship", leading to a job offer of further full-time employment if successfully completed.
