Qualifications

MS or PhD from an accredited university in Statistics or a related field and some teaching experience. Demonstrated excellence in teaching with the use of modern pedagogical techniques is preferred.

The application package should include a cover letter, curriculum vitae, a statement of teaching philosophy, and a list of three references (including phone numbers and email addresses).
